

Just Transitions to Decarbonisation in the Asia-Pacific

The award limit is £100k. Is this the 80% figure or the 100% FEC figure?

The maximum amount that can be applied for is £100,000. Within that limit you may claim for 80% FEC. The salaries, estates and indirect costs for internationally based Co-Applicants are eligible. It is up to you to make the case for the level of funding you think is required for the application. You will note that one of the assessment criteria is value for money.

The budget table indicates that all costs should be entered at 80% FEC but my costs for international collaborators will not be calculated at this level. How should I enter this on the application form?

Please enter international collaborator costs in the budget table at the level of funding you believe is required and explain this clearly in the financial justification section of the form.

My application form is complete, but the 'submit' button isn't appearing. What can I do?

Your application may appear complete on the Summary page; however, you will need to check that any other contributors have completed their pages and marked them as complete. Once this has been done, and all the other pages have been completed, the 'submit' button should appear.
