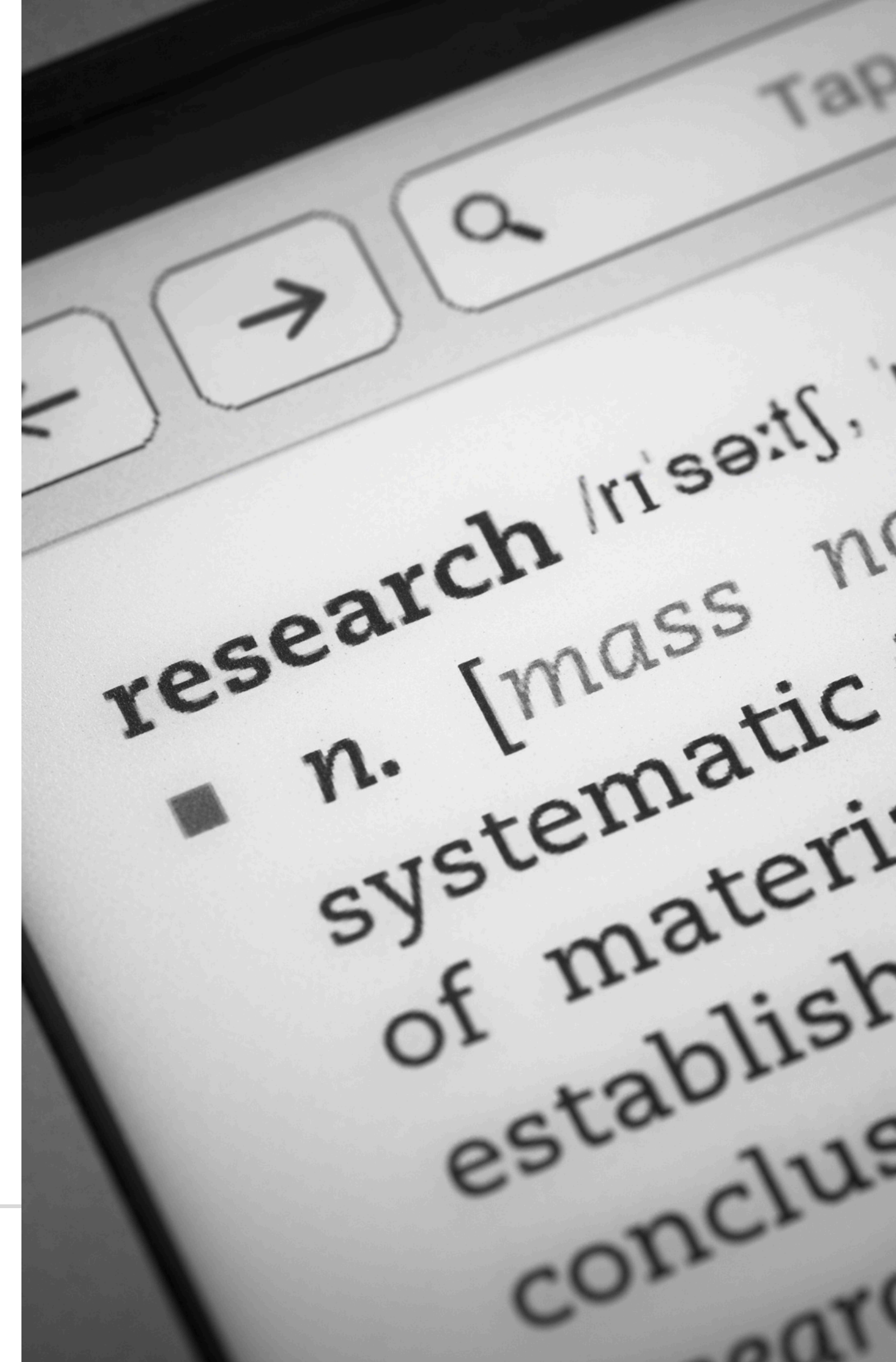


# What is Global Studies Laboratory?

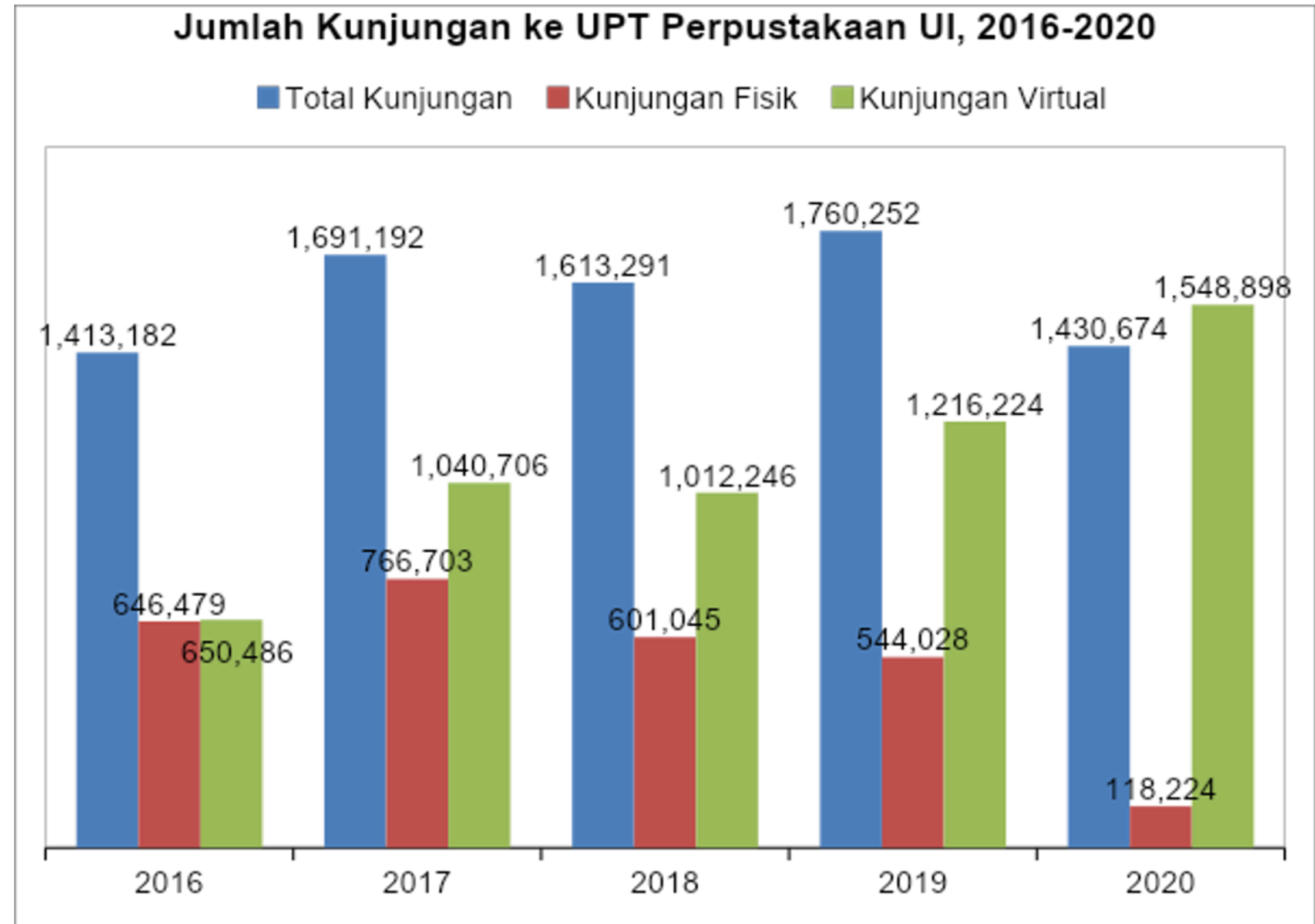

# Central Library Visitation Rate prior to COVID-19 Outbreak





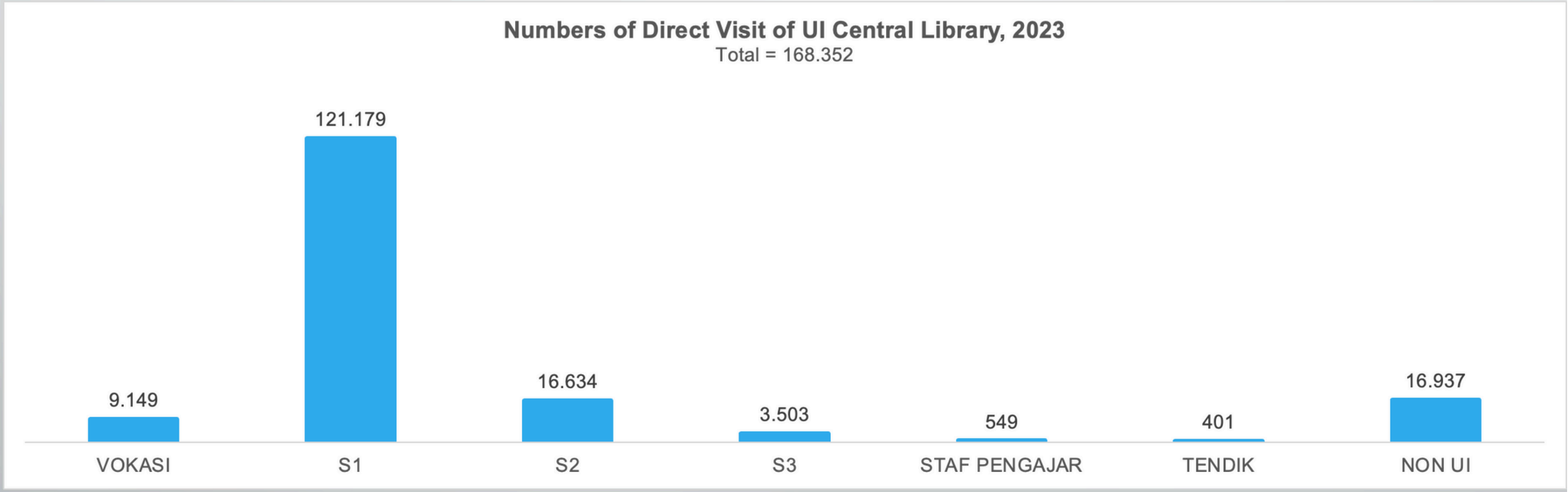

Observation carried out for 2 weeks in South Kalimantan and discovered the problems occurred in the riverbank society

## Research Conducted by Social Policy & Community Resilience CR through PUTI scheme (internal grant)

Research identified urbanization and mining are two factors eroding the value and function of lanting

## Research has managed to secure fund from Global Development Network
