

Newton Mobility Grants 2018 Round 2

Frequently Asked Questions

This document is being updated regularly in light of questions which are being asked. Please keep referring to it.

I am from a country not listed in the Scheme Notes, can I still apply?

Only applicants that have a full or fixed term contract at an eligible research institution within the following countries are eligible to apply: China, Mexico, South Africa, Thailand and Turkey.

Applicants from China must currently hold a permanent or fixed-term contract (lasting the duration of the award) at either Fudan or Peking University.

Do all candidates from China need to be employed at either Fudan University or Peking University?

Yes, only applicants that currently hold a permanent or fixed-term contract (lasting the duration of the award) at either Fudan or Peking University are eligible to apply from China.

Is there an age limit on the award?

No, the British Academy has no age criterion for this award. Instead, eligible applicants are expected to be early career researchers (defined as 0-7 years post-doc or equivalent experience) are typically invited to be the Lead Applicant on applications for this programme, however, academics who are at more developed career stage are also allowed to be the Lead Applicant.

I can't find my host institution on the drop-down list?

Please choose the UK Co-host organisation in this section of the application form. If the UK Co-host organisation does not appear in the drop-down list, you will need to contact the British Academy at newtonfund@britac.ac.uk.

I have not yet completed my PhD, can I still apply?

No, both the lead-applicant and co-applicant must have completed their PhD (or have equivalent research experience) by the date of application.
